Empowering Educators: Brian Mendler's Transformative Approach to Building Resilience and Connection in the Classroom

On October 16th, Oakmont Education's 450 employees across 20 schools had the privilege of attending a dynamic session with the amazing Brian Mendler!

"Scream your struggles. Whisper your strengths." This idea guides the work of Brian Mendler, educator and author of the bestselling book, "That One Kid." The challenges Mr. Mendler faced are experiences some of our students know all too well. By leaning into the discomfort of those challenges, he was able to transform the lessons he's learned into insights about how to diffuse power struggles with students and build stronger relationships. "Do you have the ability to stay personally connected to a student without taking personally what they do and say?" This question puts front and center the idea that in order to teach the students in our classrooms the content that is so important, we need to first prioritize modeling for them how to do hard things. The hardest of the challenges we face in life are often not math problems, but how to handle strong emotions. How do we treat others with respect, even when they are being disrespectful?

Throughout his presentation, Mr. Mendler offered key phrases that ground him in this practice, such as, "Retrain your brain to listen to what students are saying, not how they say it," "You can only change yourself," and "Questions are kryptonite for oppositional students." Acronyms like "HOPE- Hearing Other People's Experiences," and "Listen Acknowledge Agree Defer" are simple and effective touchstones. Instead of "being the fish that gets hooked," and pouring gasoline on the the fire of students' trauma, we can consider Mr. Mendler's central messagethat we need to lead by example. We can be much more effective at empowering our students and teaching them that not only can they learn how to balance an equation, but they can learn to never aive up hope.
